



We're accepting registrations for our next session of Street Hockey that will begin play Sunday, January 11.

Street Hockey is also known as dek hockey, ball hockey or floor hockey. Street hockey is played using the rules of ice hockey with two major differences: No ice and no skates. The game is played on a hard plastic surface and players wear tennis shoes. The only required equipment for adults is gloves, a stick and it is highly recommended you wear shin guards and a mouth guard. Each team must wear t-shirts or hockey jerseys that are the same color and they must have a unique number of a contrasting color. If you're under 18 you **MUST** wear an HECC certified helmet with a full cage or shield, mouth guard, shin/knee pads and hockey gloves. Street Hockey is a non-checking sport (incidental contact is allowed) with 5 players and a goaltender on each team and is played with a low bounce ball.

We have two divisions:

Co-ed - teams are a combination of beginners and experienced players. Each team must have at least one woman on the floor at all times

Competitive - more advanced players and a little more intense. Teams may be any combination of men and women including none of one or the other. Players may play in both leagues.

Games in the Co-ed division are played Sunday mornings and Competitive games are played early to mid-Sunday afternoons. If there is an odd number of teams, teams will occasionally play double headers so teams don't have byes.

Sessions include 10 games plus playoffs for all teams. Cost is \$800 per team and this includes all rink, referee and scorekeeper fees (there are no hidden fees).
